- Register your team and identify a team captain or contact person.
- Once registered, your team captain will be mailed pledge envelopes.

## 2 Start Securing Sponsorships

• Each team member then collects sponsorships to bowl. Each bowler must raise a minimum of \$35. Each person raising \$50 gets a free t-shirt.

#### 3 Start Bowling

- Attend the event and enjoy free food, two games of free bowling (shoes included), free
  entertainment, Minute to Win It Games, and lots of prize giveaways throughout the night. The top 3
  individual bowler(s) raising the most money, at each event, are recognized with major prizes
  donated by area businesses. Last year major prizes included local restaurant, gas, and grocery
  store gift certificates.

#### A Few Ideas Bowl For Kids' Sake Teams Have Used To Raise Funds

- Ask coworkers, friends and family members to sponsor you.
- Send a request to all your Email/Facebook contacts that describes the benefits of mentoring, why you would like a donation, and how to make a donation to support your Bowl For Kids' Sake team. Set a goal for the amount of money that your team would like to raise and keep donors informed of your progress toward meeting your goal.
- Host some type of contest at school or work. Charge an entrance fee to participate. Specify
  that fees will support Bowl For Kids' Sake teams. Make funny trophies or provide some sort of
  perk for the winners such as a special place in line at lunch, a special parking spot, or starting
  their car for them at the end of the day for a specified amount of time.
- Request to have a dress down day at your place of business or a dress up day at your school.
  Have each person contribute an established amount of money to participate. The amount
  could be anywhere from \$1 \$5 per person. Let participants know that the money raised will
  be used to sponsor Bowl For Kids' Sake teams from your organization, business or school.
- Post bowling pin ups with names of donors at your business or school. Contact Big Brothers Big Sisters at 1-877-776-1636 to request pin ups.
- Partner with or ask a business to match any personal donations that your team collects.
- Ask permission to have a tag day in front of a local market. Ask customers to sponsor your Bowl For Kids' Sake team and explain that all proceeds support Big Brothers Big Sisters.
   Contact Big Brothers Big Sisters at 1-877-776-1636 for tag slips to distribute.
- Have a soup or bake sale.
- Host a Wii bowling tournament. Charge an entry fee to participate.
- Offer a service in exchange for sponsorships for example walking dogs, shoveling snow, a night of babysitting, etc.
- Host a neighborhood movie night or sled riding party. Send out flyers to friends and neighbors.
   Provide snacks or hot chocolate for a donation. Let everyone know that the money raised will sponsor your Bowl For Kids' Sake team and benefit Big Brothers Big Sisters.
- Ask friends, family members, or co-workers to donate unwanted Christmas gifts or other items they no longer want and have an indoor auction or rummage sale to raise funds.
